Foundation Financials: A Snapshot

The CMHC Foundation supports the hospital with grants drawn from its assets, which are comprised of donations and other income. As of December 31, 2018, total assets under management for the Foundation were \$258,529, a decline of \$50,000 from the previous year-end. This is due to the large value of grants, \$82,552, which was partially offset by fundraising. Because of anticipated needs for grant funds for the large bed replacement project, current assets are primarily held in cash and money market accounts and deferred gifts of life insurance policies.

The Foundation received income of over \$52,000 from donations and fundraising—particularly the gala and golf tournament, as well as restricted and unrestricted gifts and memorials—plus investment and interest income. Overall, the Foundation had about \$103,000 in expenses.

**CMHC Foundation Celebrates
25 Years**

The Community Memorial Hospital and Clinic Foundation is proud to celebrate its 25th anniversary in 2019. Created in 1994 to respond to a need for a handicapped-accessible entrance, the Foundation has raised funds to support the Community Memorial Hospital and Clinic through grants.

In 1997, the Foundation raised more than \$750,000 to build its assets and enable it to purchase equipment needed by the hospital. In a 2009 campaign, the Foundation raised more than \$250,000 to furnish the hospital's renovation and expansion project. Over the years, the Foundation has made hundreds of thousands of dollars in other grants for hospital projects, including more than \$80,000 in 2018.

Foundation Supports Bed Purchases

In 2018, the Community Memorial Hospital and Clinic Foundation purchased four beds to support the hospital's bed replacement project. In 2017, the hospital learned that new regulations required replacing 18 patient beds. The Foundation committed to purchase 12 of the replacements over three years. The hospital will purchase the remainder. The purchases will total approximately \$160,000.

Grants Support Hospital

In 2018, The Foundation made grants to the hospital of 82,552. The largest grant was for the purchase of four beds, totaling \$55,000. In addition, grants supported the purchase of two mobile device charging stations for waiting areas in the hospital, three hospital carts for transporting patients, and six chairs for a nurses station. The grants were the largest transfers to the hospital in about a decade.

Foundation Holds Successful Golf Tourney

The annual CMHC Foundation golf tournament in June 2018 at Fishers Grove Country Club drew dozens of golfers and raised nearly \$3,900 to support grants to the hospital. The top-finishing teams earned prizes, and many golfers won donated prizes in contests on the course.
